Remanded on drug charge

Three adults who appeared on drugs charges in the Juvenile Court were further remanded on bail for a week.

Robert Dunne (34) and Theresa Dunne (33) of Dolphin House, Rialto, are charged with being in possession of a controlled drug, Diamorphine, for the purpose of supplying it to persons unknown on November 4 last.

A third defendant, Mrs. Helena Tighe, (32) of Fatima Mansions, is also charged with possession of Diamorphine for the purpose of supplying it.

Rapped for closed doors

An industry at Falcarragh, Co. Donegal, that closed the doors on its workforce last Monday morning without any prior notice was sharply criticised by Udaras na Gaeltachta yesterday.

When the 20 workers arrived at the premises of Connerrigal Industry Ltd., which manufactures protective clothing for industrial use, they found the factory gates closed and no one available to offer any explanation.
